spanning 12 years don t call me urban is a fascinating photographic portrayal of underground music culture and social alienation capturing the era when london s inner city youth found an authentic voice simon wheatley s incisive eye goes into the raw environment from which the new stars of british popular music such as dizzee rascal and tinchy stryder have emerged

youth unemployment in the uk remains around the one million mark with many young people from impoverished backgrounds becoming and remaining neet not in education employment or training however the neet categorisation covertly disguises and obscures the significance of the diverse range of activities achievements and accomplishments of those who operate in the informal creative economy with grime music and its related enterprise a key component of the urban music economy this book employs the inherent contradictions and questions that emerge from an exploration of the grime music scene to build a complex reading of the socio economic significance of urban music incorporating insightful dialogue with the participants in this economy white challenges the prevailing wisdom on marginalised young people whilst also confronting the assumption that the inertia and localisation of the grime culture results from its close links to neet members and the informal sector offering an ethnographic and timely critique of the neet classification this compelling book would be suitable for undergraduate and post graduate students interested in urban studies business work and labour education and employment ethnography music and cultural studies

this edition of herzog on herzog presents a completely new set of interviews in which werner herzog discusses his career from its very beginnings to his most recent productions herzog was once hailed by francois truffaut as the most important director alive famous for his frequent collaborations with mercurial actor klaus kinski including the epics *aguirre the wrath of god* and *fitzcarraldo* and the terrifying *nosferatu* and more recently with documentaries such as *grizzly man* *cave of forgotten dreams* and *into the abyss* herzog has built a body of work that is one of the most vital in post war german cinema

a mobster learns he s becoming a god only to discover they die too the right hand of the dominant mob family raine morgan is tasked with hunting down two miscreants messing with the bottom line he finds them on the docks but in the confusion of the fight accidentally kills their victim and lets them escape horrified at what he s done raine seeks redemption as well as revenge things spiral out of control when a greedy middleman overthrows raine s mob organization it s only with the help of a friend inside the crumbling mob as well as a streetwise artist that raine remains undetected as he searches for the men who started this all raine doesn t realize however he has caught the attention of a disparate conclave of gods in the process as the pantheon returns to the city they d abandoned old conflicts re emerge causing divine civil war both sides try to pull raine to their side expecting to find a naive god for them to manipulate instead they find a man stripped of everything intent on playing both sides as they learn an awful reality even gods can die

in this outdoors mystery special agent sam rivers investigates the unexplained and very unlikely cougar attack that killed a wealthy business owner the sighting of a cougar in the minnesota river valley outside the twin cities is incredibly rare a deadly cougar attack on a human in this area is about as likely as getting struck by lightning twice yet when wealthy business owner jack mcgregor is found dead the physical evidence seems incontrovertible sheriff rusty benson brings in sam rivers a us fish wildlife usfw special agent and a wildlife biologist to examine the scene and sign off on his conclusions but sam s experiences have given him a penchant for understanding predators and he has more questions than answers details begin to surface that challenge law enforcement s open and shut case to find justice sam must take matters into his own hands he enlists the help of reporter diane talbott and his wolf dog gray who s in training to become a working dog

for the usfw gray s nose leads the investigation in unexpected directions the more rocks sam turns over the more motives for murdering mcgregor seem to slither out with no help or support from local law enforcement sam and his team are all that stand between justice and those who might otherwise get away with murder sam s knowledge of backcountry cougars and the criminal mind will be put to the test as he tries to solve the case and stay alive in cougar claw natural history writer cary j griffith brings back sam rivers the predator s predator and pens a puzzling mystery filled with suspense and intrigue
